Steve Hoskinson discussed a near miss – an ARC flash in a flour mill.

Leon Mueller, EFS/MSHA, discussed structural failure alert and they are setting up a Train the Trainer class. He also discussed work place exams standings – it is still in limbo.

There is a new OSHA rule, effective December 1, 2106 - Employers can not automatically drug test employees for incidents.

Nathan Steele gave the treasurers report – raised \$2263 in September bringing our total to \$6254.65.
